**Directions:**

Christ Church is located on the corner of Military and Cherry Hill, four blocks north of Michigan Avenue and one mile east of Telegraph Road.

**From the North:**

Take the Southfield Expressway (M-39) to Michigan Avenue west exit. Continue on Michigan Avenue into the West Dearborn shopping district to Military (Sacred Heart Catholic Church on corner). Turn north (right) onto Military, go four blocks to Cherry Hill.

**From the South:**

Take the Fisher Freeway (I-75) to Telegraph Road (24) go north to Cherry Hill (just north of Michigan Avenue). Go east (right) on Cherry Hill (about 1 mile) to Military.

**From the East:**

Take the Ford Freeway (I-94) to Michigan Avenue west exit. Continue on Michigan Avenue past the Southfield Expressway (M-39) into the West Dearborn shopping district to Military (Sacred Heart Catholic Church on corner). Turn north (right) on Military, go four blocks to Cherry Hill.

**From the West:**

Take the Ford Freeway (I-94) to Telegraph Road (24) north exit. Continue north on Telegraph to Cherry Hill (just north of Michigan Avenue). Go east (right) on Cherry Hill for one mile to Military.
